

# Diamond Self-Certification Form

## Purpose

U.S. Customs and Border Protection requires this certification for any shipment containing diamonds.

This form confirms that **no diamonds or diamond jewelry in your shipment were sourced from Russia, except as permitted under Sections A, B, or C.**

## Important

Fill out this form and place it inside the package for any shipment going to a U.S. buyer.

If the form isn't included, your item may be held by U.S. Customs and Border Protection and could be returned.

## Instructions for Sellers

1. Review the certification statements below.
  2. **Select all statements that apply** to your shipment.
    - a. You may need to check more than one box if your shipment includes different diamond types (e.g., loose stones and jewelry).
  3. Copy the selected statements **exactly as written** onto your **company letterhead**.
  4. **Print, sign, and date** the form.
  5. Place the signed copy **inside your package** before shipping to a U.S. buyer.

## Section A: Non-Industrial Diamonds (1.0 carat or greater)

### Option 1

> "I certify that the non-industrial diamonds in this shipment were not mined, extracted, produced, or manufactured wholly or in part in the Russian Federation, notwithstanding whether such diamonds have been substantially transformed into other products outside of the Russian Federation."

### Option 2

> "I certify that the non-industrial diamonds in this shipment qualify for General License 104, because the diamonds were physically located outside of the Russian Federation before March 1, 2024, and were not exported or re-exported from the Russian Federation since March 1, 2024."

## Section B: Diamond Jewelry and Unsorted Diamonds

**Option 1**

> “I certify that the diamond jewelry and unsorted diamonds in this shipment are not of Russian Federation origin and were not exported from the Russian Federation.”

**Option 2**

> “I certify that the diamond jewelry in this shipment qualifies for General License 103 and that it was physically located outside of the Russian Federation prior to March 1, 2024, and not exported or reexported from the Russian Federation on or after March 1, 2024.”

## Section C: Non-Industrial Diamonds (0.5 carat or greater, effective September 1, 2024)

**Option 1**

> “I certify that the non-industrial diamonds in this shipment were not mined, extracted, produced, or manufactured wholly or in part in the Russian Federation, notwithstanding whether such diamonds have been substantially transformed into other products outside of the Russian Federation.”

**Option 2**

> “I certify that the non-industrial diamonds in this shipment qualify for General License 104, because the diamonds were physically located outside of the Russian Federation before March 1, 2024, and were not exported or re-exported from the Russian Federation since March 1, 2024.”
