

eBay Ties Up With Drop-off Centers to Improve the Local Online Auction Experience

Hong Kong, February 7, 2006 - eBay Hong Kong announced that beginning February 8, buyers and sellers trading on eBay.com.hk can use one of two drop-off centers located in Causeway Bay and Mongkok to handle delivery and payment of auction items.

The new service, which is run by a third party not under eBay's management, is being launched after feedback from eBay's local community, requesting for such an offering.

"eBay is eager to improve the online shopping experience in Hong Kong and reduce the time our community spends meeting in person to settle delivery," said Kerry Wong, Managing Director of eBay Hong Kong. "Our aim with the drop-off centers is to complement our existing effort, in providing a convenient and safe way to trade online."

Buyers can choose to settle payment by credit card, EPS or cash when they pick up items at the centers, while sellers can drop off items anytime within opening hours. A fixed service charge will be billed to sellers based on the size of the item.
