

eBay Hong Kong Expands Its Local Online Trading Community to Include English Language Users

Hong Kong, September 3, 2007 – eBay, the world's largest online marketplace, today announced the much anticipated launch of the English language version of its Hong Kong site.

The company is responding to the needs of the community and the increasing requests from its users to create an English site in Hong Kong. The new beta site will give eBay Hong Kong members the option of registering, searching, bidding and selling in English language. The English site will have obvious benefits for members in Hong Kong who cannot read Chinese. The beta English language version will further facilitate cross-border trade in Hong Kong by allowing local members to easily interact with overseas sellers in the eBay community.

Furthermore, the new site will allow Hong Kong buyers to filter listings based on the seller accepting PayPal as the payment method. PayPal is an eBay company that enables any individual or business with an email address to securely, easily and quickly send and receive payments online. PayPal is used in the vast majority of cross-border trading on the eBay platform, where millions of items are traded each day.
