Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Why was my auction removed?

A: We cannot permit the infringing use of any of our intellectual property on eBay. The

confused, and also helps to prevent generic uses of valuable marks, as well as dilution,

disparagement, or other diminishment of goodwill and reputation. We ask that eBay users

respect our rights and please seek counsel before engaging in any activity that might violate

our trademark rights, or those of any other trademark owner.

Q: Why was my auction singled out when there are similar items still for sale on eBay?

A: We work hard to ensure that any auctions that contain infringements of our intellectual

property are removed from eBay as soon as possible. However, given the popularity of our

brand name, the high volume of merchandise for sale on eBay, and the frequency of newly

added auctions, it is difficult to immediately identify and remove every infringing item. If it

appears we have not yet acted against an infringing auction that does not mean we will not

act, or that the auction is not in violation of United States and international laws

Q: Why did eBay allow me to post my auction?

A: eBay is unable to pre-screen their auctions for all unauthorized uses. Therefore,

just because eBay posted your auction does not mean that the sale is legal

Q: Why I cannot use the word "All About Her" in my auction heading even though I am not selling

an All About Her item?

A: The All About Her name is a registered trademark for a wide range of products as well as

for retail services, and may only be used with the authorization of Al About Her. You should

not use the All About Her name in connection with the sale of goods that come from a source

other than All About Her.

Q: If I purchased an authentic item of All About Her merchandise, can I re-sell the item on eBay?

A: Yes. It is legal to re-sell a genuine item that you purchased, in its original, unaltered form.

Nevertheless, it is impermissible to use All About Her's copyrighted images to promote the sale of the item.

In addition, you cannot use All About Her's trademarks and logos to make your auction more appealing. You

are prohibited from producing an unauthorized copy of legitimate merchandise and offering it for sale.

Q: Can I list an item if I expressly say that it is "NOT GENUINE," "FAKE," or a "KNOCK
OFF"?

A: No. A disclaimer regarding the authenticity of goods does not relieve a seller from liability for the

manufacture, distribution and/or sale of unlicensed, counterfeit goods. Such activity is criminal and

may subject you to the payment of monetary fines and imprisonment.

Q: Can I use All About Her's logo or other logos or properties owned by All About Her's to make my auction

listing more appealing?

A: No. Use of these All About Her's logos or other intellectual properties wrongfully implies that your

auction is authorized, sponsored, or approved by All About Her, and dilutes the value of these logos in

violation of state and federal trademark laws.

Q: How can I determine whether an item for sale on eBay is a genuine All About Her

product? _
