What should you watch out for when buying or selling Individual Software products on eBay? If you are buying a CD containing our software brands, please consider the following issues to help ensure that you obtain authentic, properly licensed software: 1. WE never sell “CD Only” or “Sleeve Only.” If you see software without Individual Software-branded packaging, do not purchase it. Also, Individual Software products never have paper or plastic CD labels stuck to the surface of a CD. Additionally, the software is always manufactured on CD-ROM media, and never on so-called CD-R discs, the recordable discs that are typically used to “burn” music and which often have serial numbering printed on the plastic inner ring of the CD. Do not purchase “Previously registered software.” If the product is being advertised as “used” or “previously registered,” the license is not transferable, and the activation key has been used. The software will not install without a valid activation key.

Acquire Individual Software products on eBay at the KBI store. KBI is Individual Software’s Authorized Reseller on eBay. KBI will always distribute Individual Software products in its original packaging. If there is no packaging, or the packaging looks strange (print quality is poor, design and color schemes appear different), do not purchase the software. The EULA for any Individual Software product does not allow resale or other transfer of a product you originally purchased for your own use.

Software piracy is the duplication, distribution, or use of software without authorization from the copyright owner. This includes actions such as selling counterfeit or unlicensed copies or downloads, making copies for (or loaning disks to) others, installing one licensed copy onto multiple computers (where the specific license terms prohibit additional installations), or using unlicensed or counterfeit copies. Software piracy is an important issue to both the seller and the buyer. Most importantly for the buyer, it can expose end-users who purchase the software to identity theft and other privacy risks, as criminals who sell counterfeit software can load viruses or spyware on the CDs they sell, and often obtain your name, address, and other personal information.
