



## eBay International Shipping My eBay How-To Guide

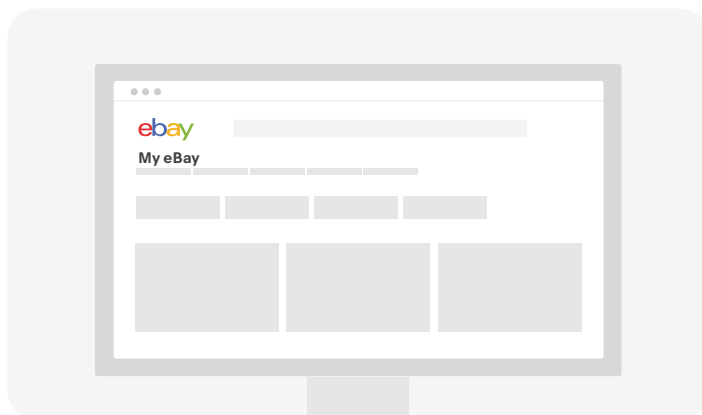
This how-to guide will take you step-by-step through updating your international listings within the My eBay platform.

In general, you'll update your current listings by removing all international shipping options. It sounds counter-intuitive, but when only domestic services remain, your job is done. Your eligible listings will then automatically be enrolled in eBay International Shipping.

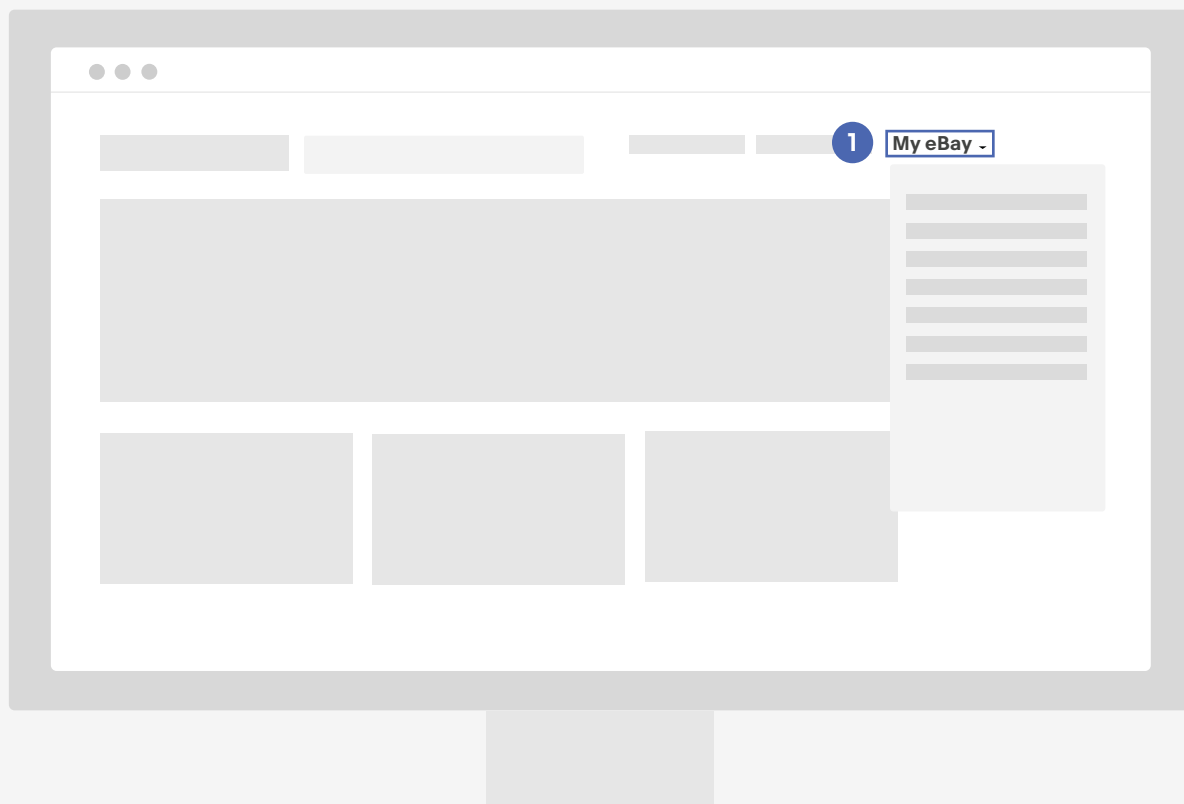
### Before you begin

Once you remove previous international services, eBay International Shipping will automatically become the default service.

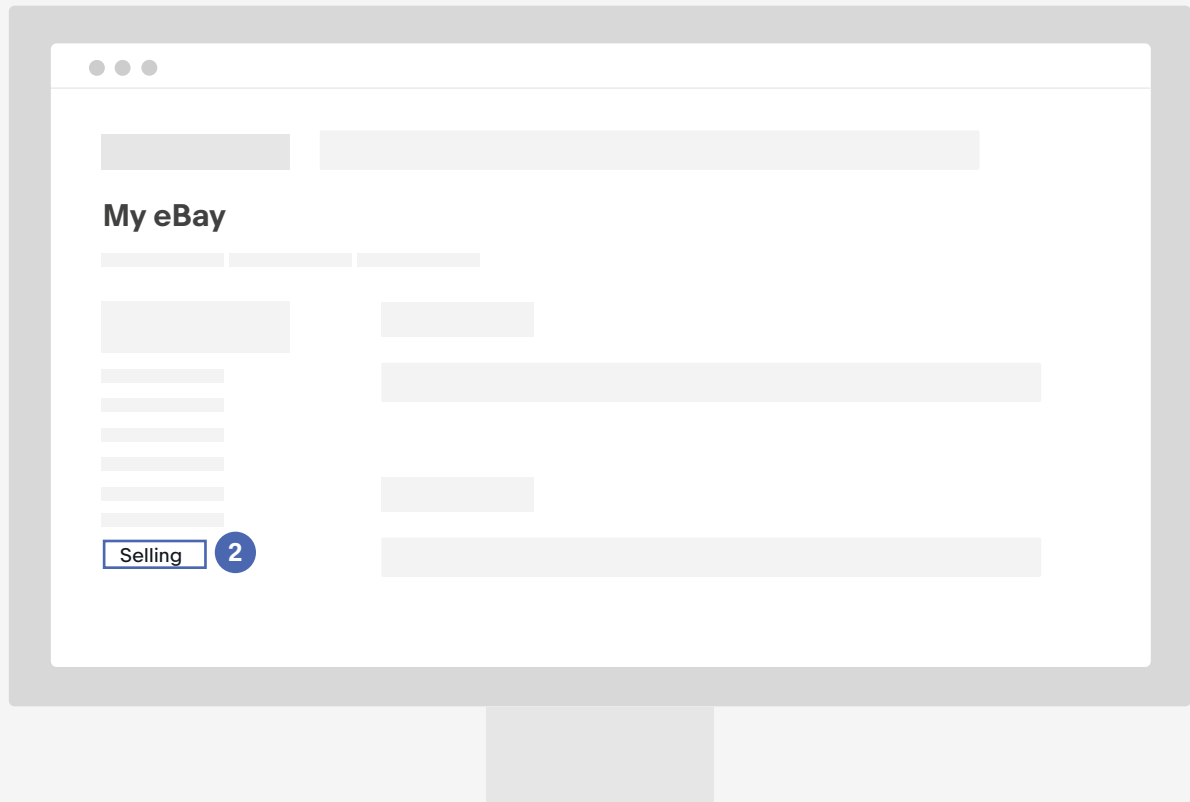

## **Step 1**

Click on “My eBay” in the top right of the screen.

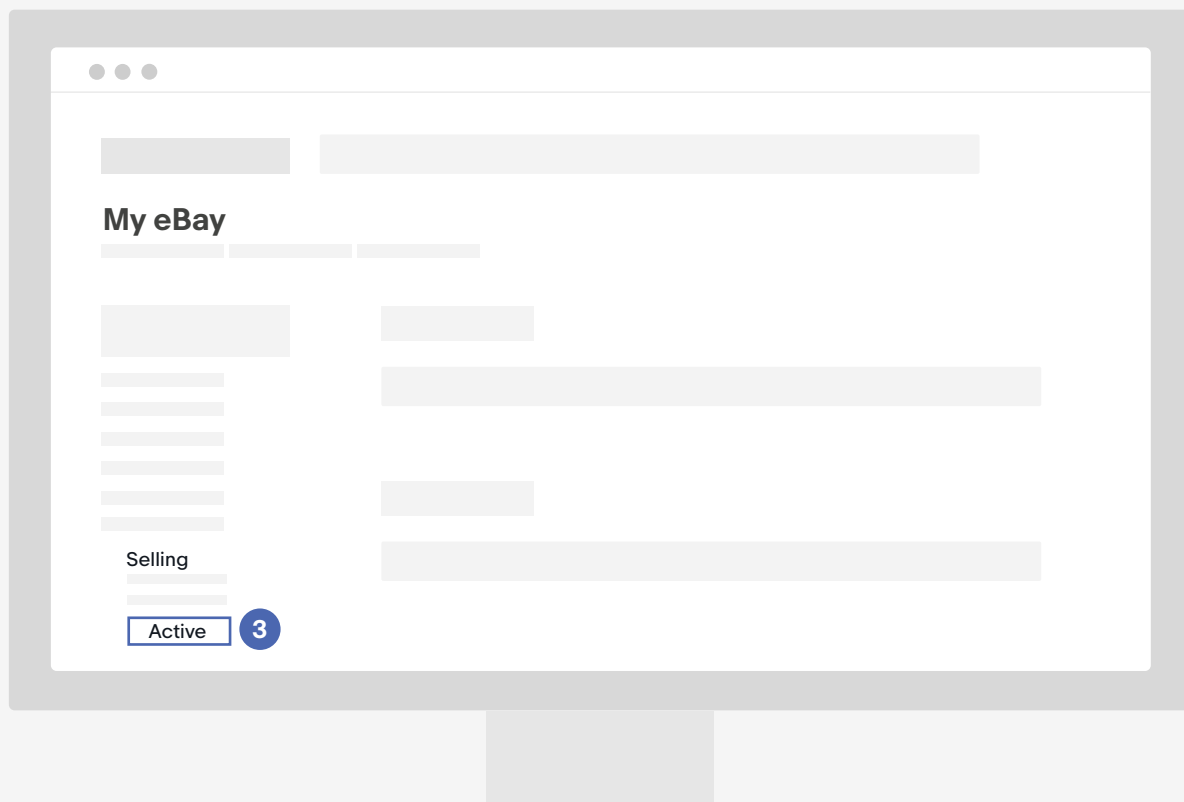

On the lefthand side, select “Selling.”

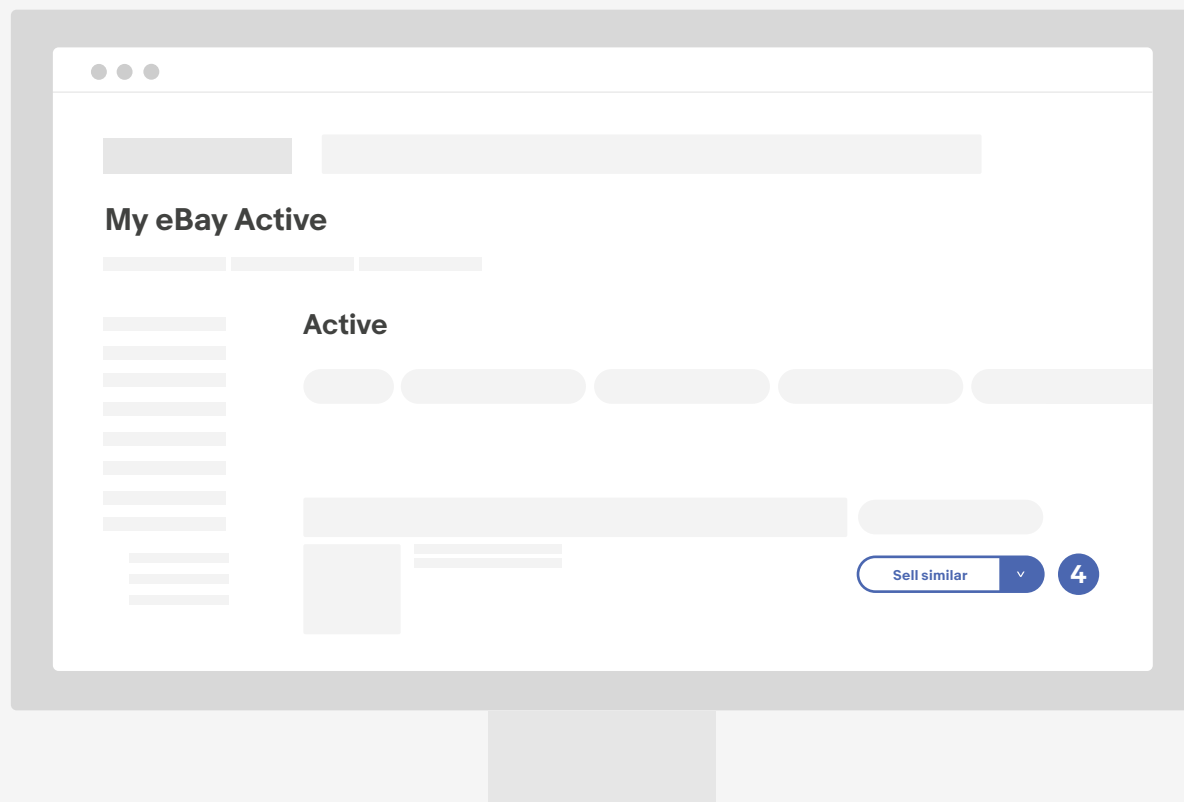

Under the selling dropdown, select “Active.”

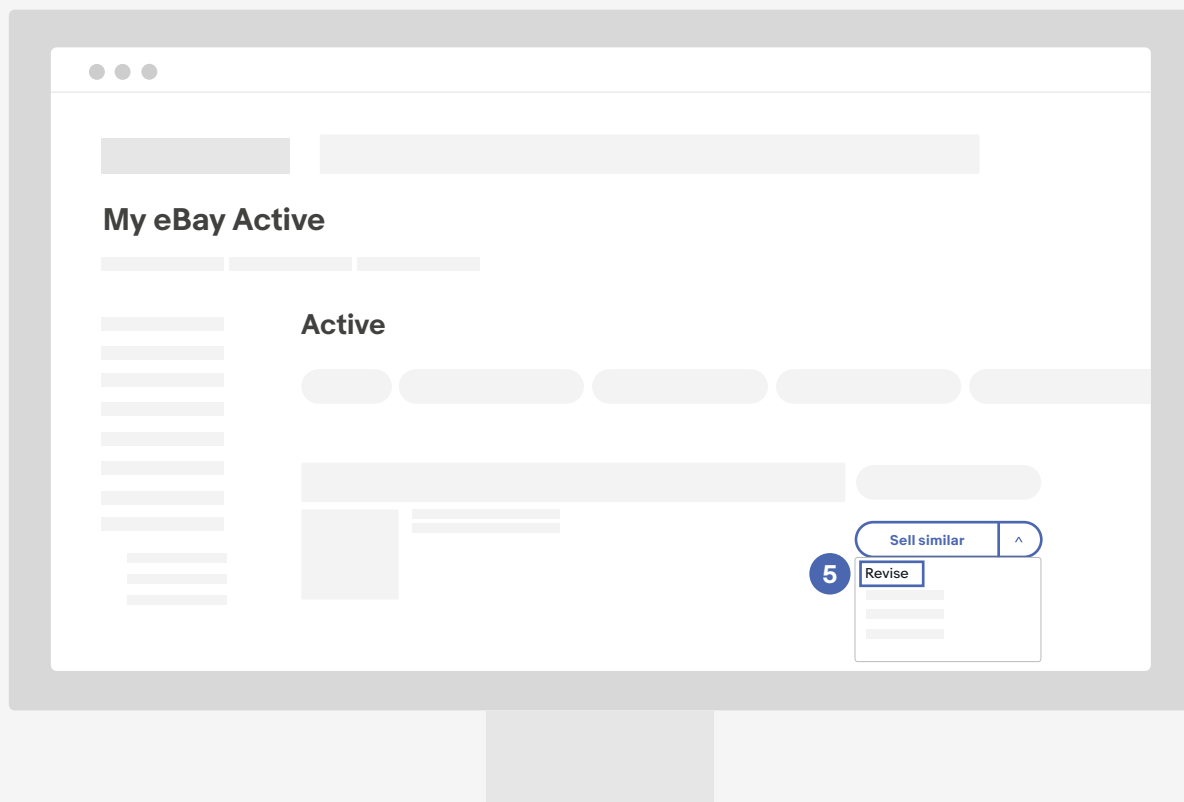

On the righthand side of your listing, click the carrot beside the “Sell similar” button.

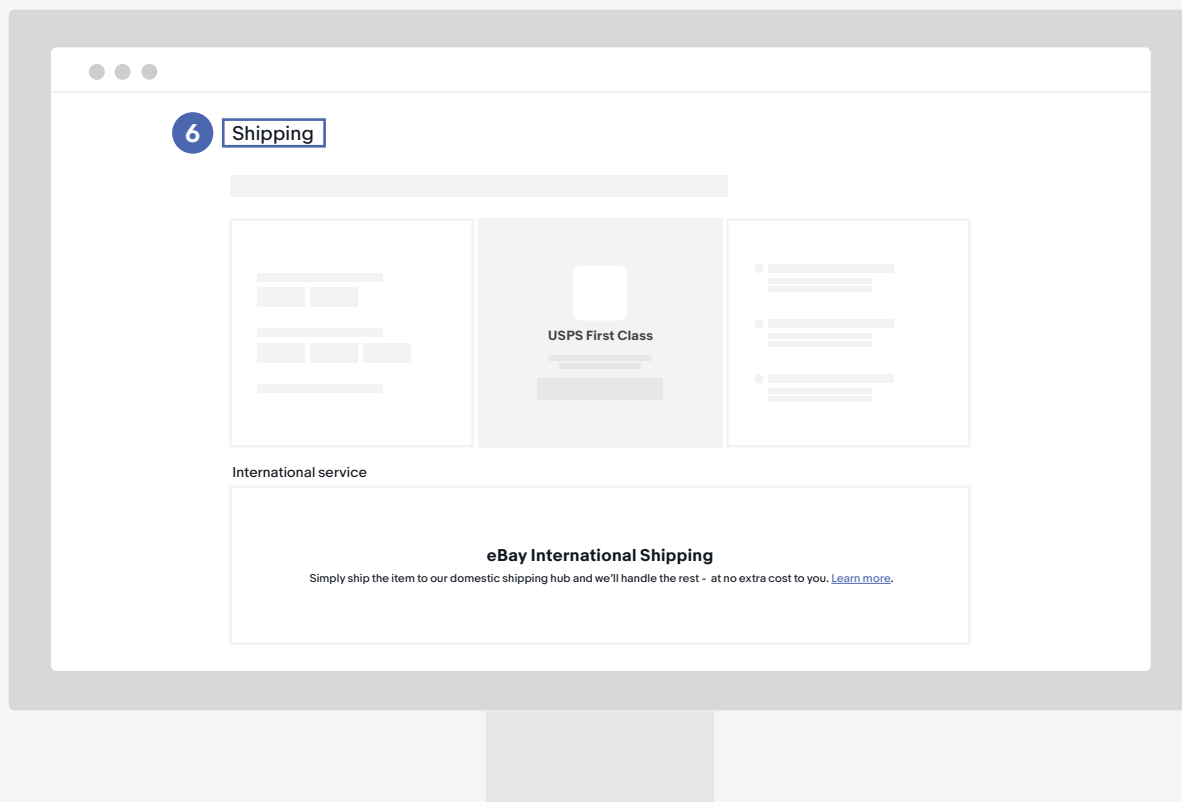

Click "Revise" from the dropdown.

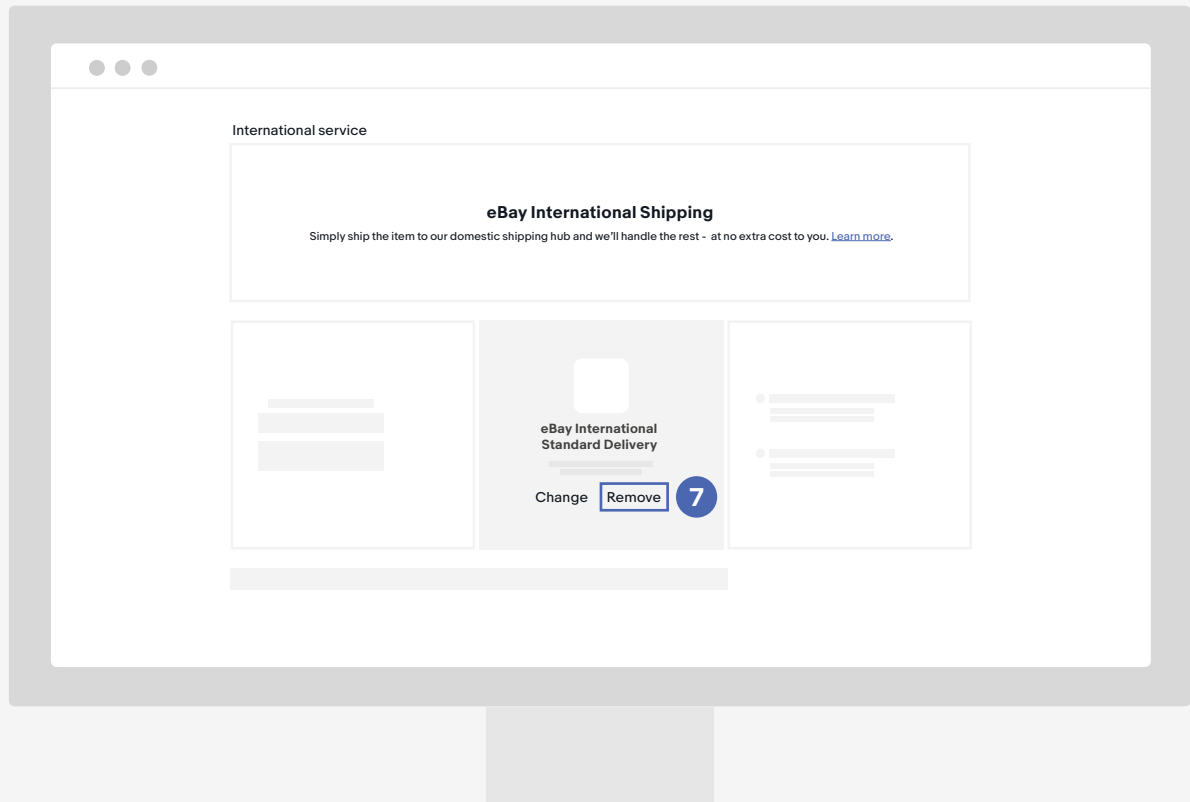

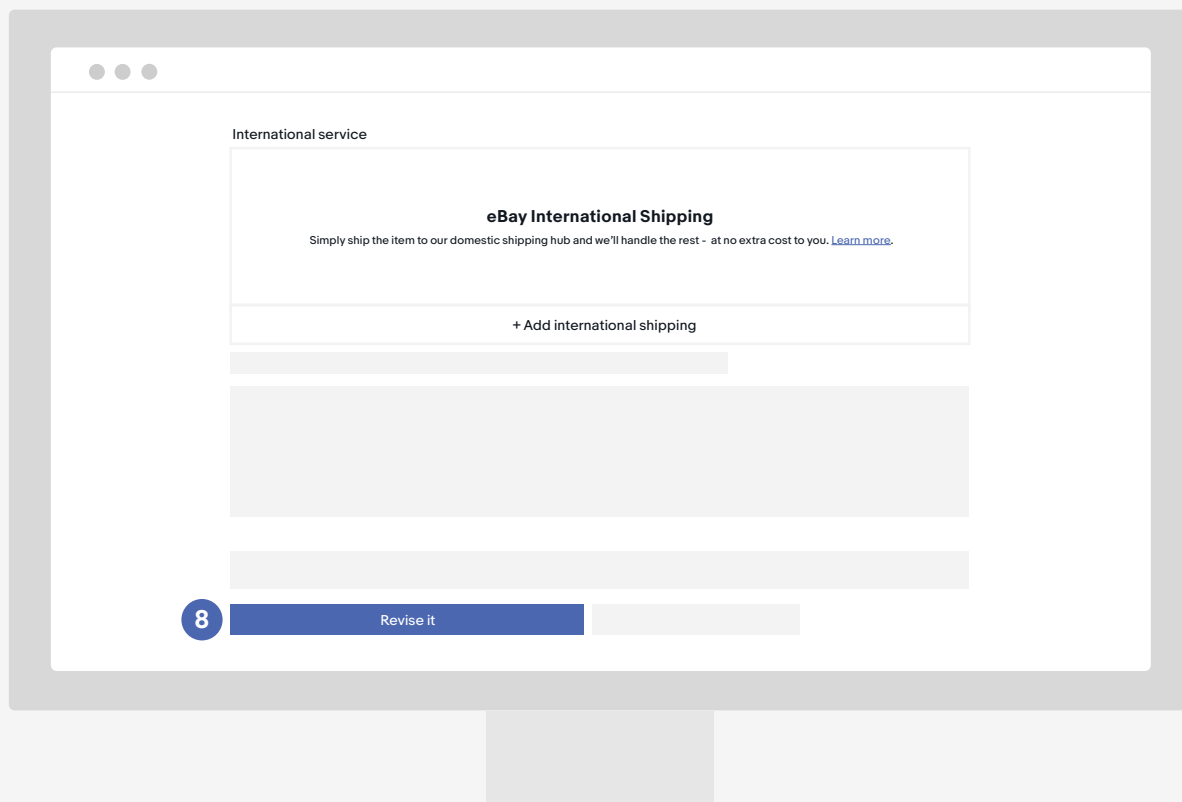


## **Step 7**
