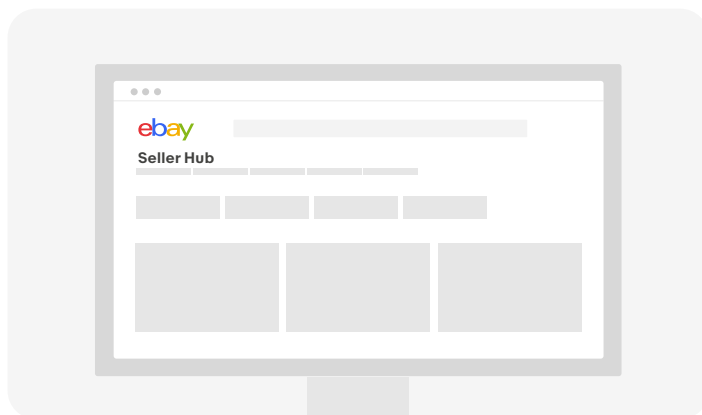
This step-by-step guide will show you how to use the Single Listing tool to update your current listings to eBay International Shipping.

Want to be sure you get protections and savings on new listings, too? You don't have to do a thing. All new, eligible listings will automatically roll into eBay International Shipping.

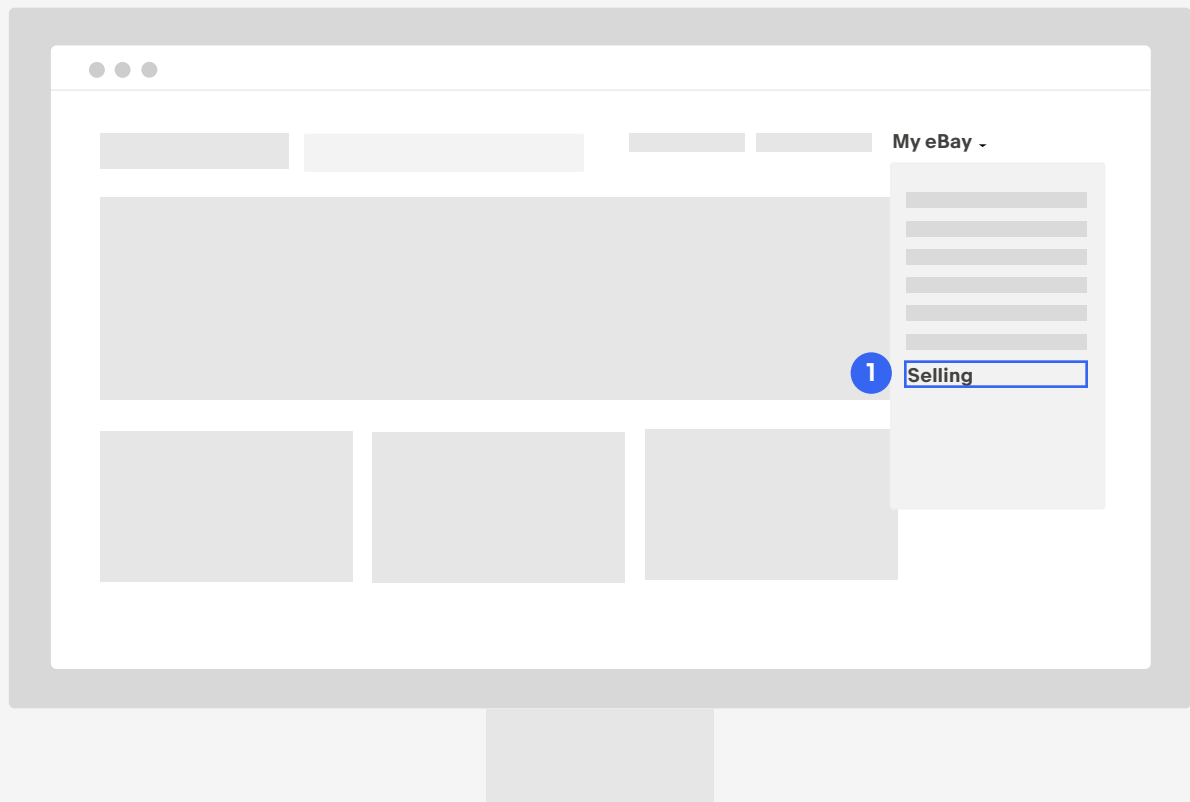
Before you begin

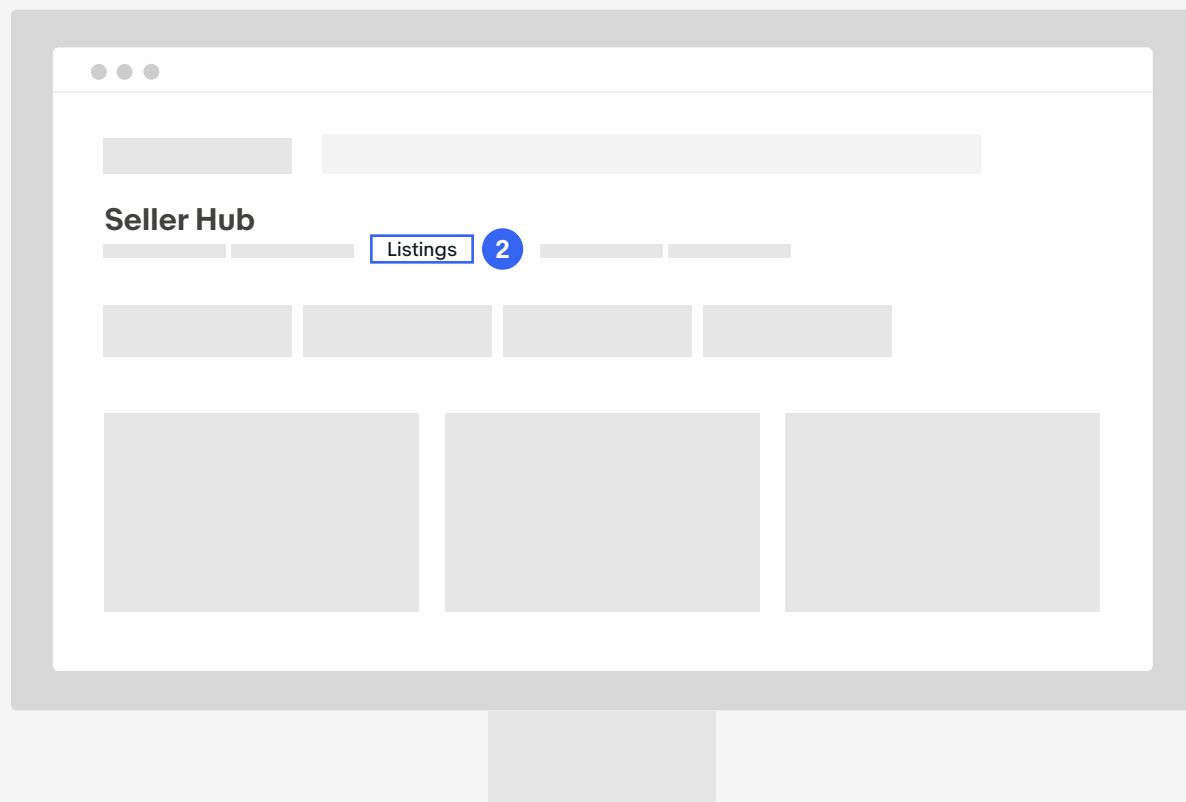
eBay International Shipping **How-to Guide**



Step 1

In the upper right corner of your screen, hover over the My eBay dropdown menu and select “Selling.”

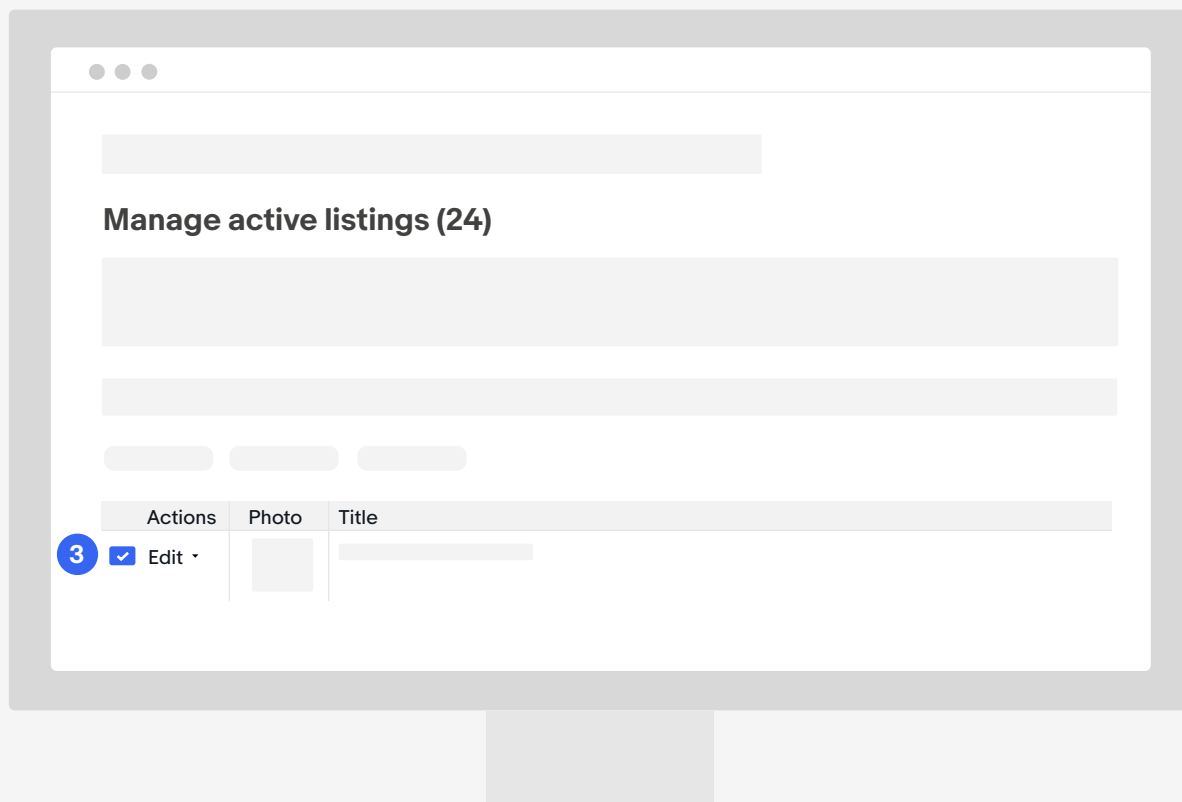

Step 2

Select "Listings" from the top menu of your Seller Hub.

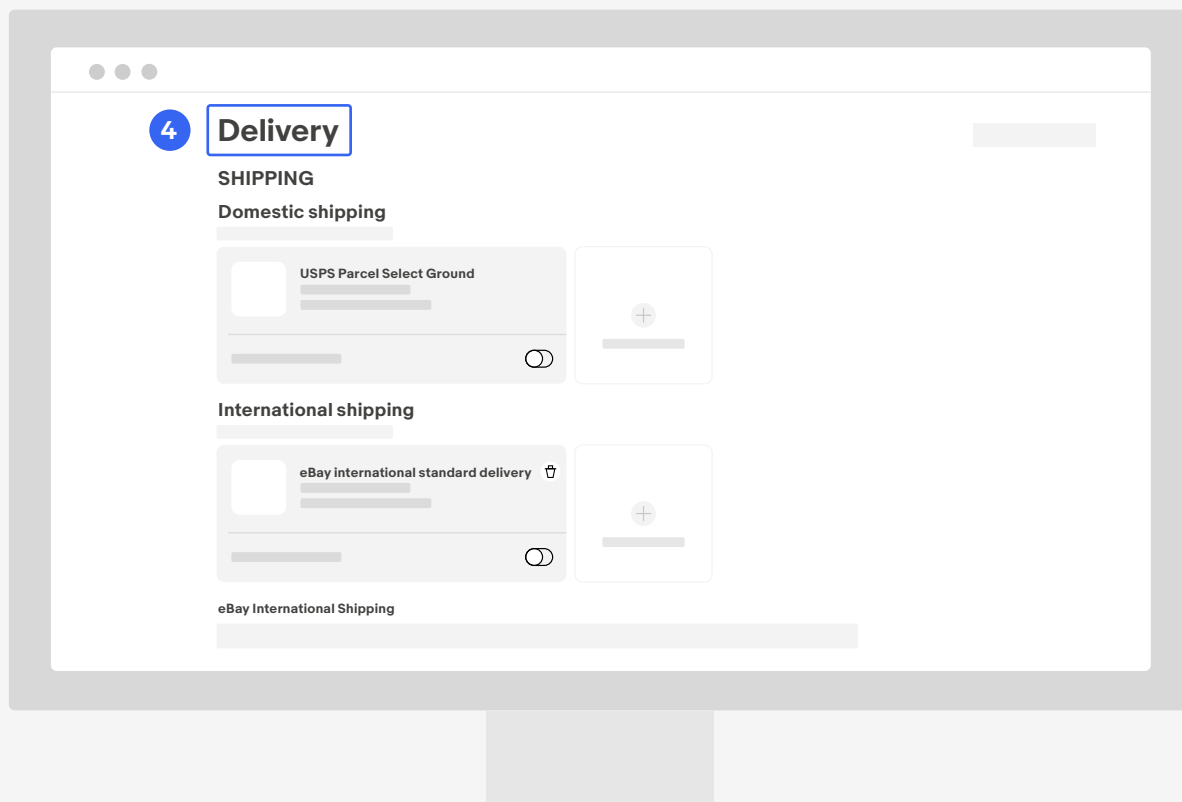

Step 3

Scroll down to your active listings and select “Edit” next to the listing you want to update.

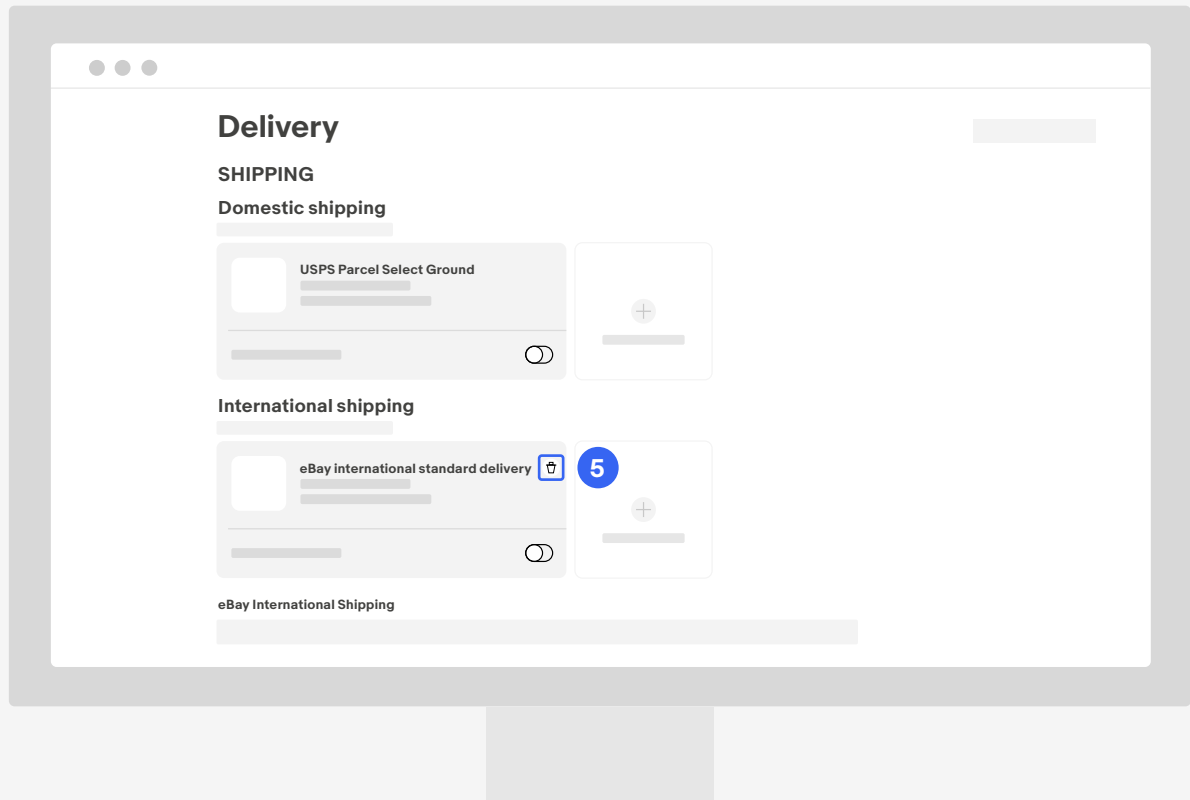

Step 4

Scroll down to the delivery section.

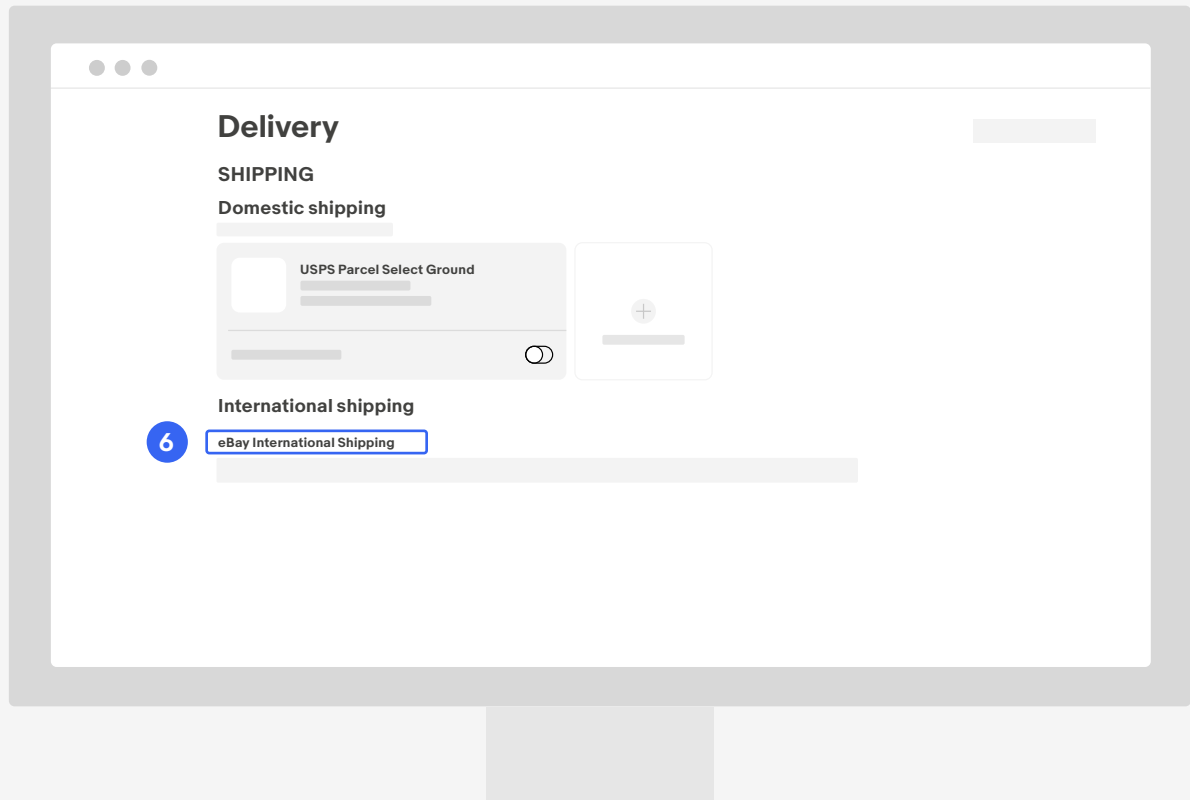


Step 5

Under “International Shipping”, click the trash can next to all other shipping services. You will need to close out of each service if more than one is available.

Once you remove those other international services, eBay International Shipping will automatically become the default service.

Step 6

To confirm eBay International Shipping is now the default on your listing, you should see only eBay International Shipping listed under the “International Shipping” section.
