






This step-by-step guide will show you how to update your business policies, and both current and future listings within them, to eBay International Shipping.

Before you begin

Once you remove those other international services from all of your business policies, eBay International Shipping will automatically become the default service on listings under this policy.




eBay International Shipping **How-to Guide**



Step 1


In the upper right corner of your screen, hover over the My eBay dropdown menu and select “Selling.”


Step 2

Hover over “Listings,” then select “Active” from the dropdown.



Step 3


Select “Business Policies” on the lefthand side.



Step 4

Select a shipping policy you want to revise.




Step 5

Within your shipping policy, scroll down to “International shipping” then choose “No International Shipping” from the dropdown.

It might seem counterintuitive, but when only domestic shipping services remain, your job is done. All your listings under this policy will be automatically opted into eBay International Shipping.


